½ Day Workshop

PERMANENT WAVING AND STRAIGHTENING TECHNIQUES

½ Day Workshop

The knowledge required to safely and effectively perform any chemical reformation is an important aspect of a student's training. This workshop is aimed to provide the student with a broad understanding of the principles for both chemical volumising and straightening services. Additional practical activities will complete this workshop.

COLOUR FOUNDATIONS AND HIGHLIGHTING TECHNIQUES

Full Day Workshop

Students will be introduced to the basic information regarding all types of hair colour services, such as the colour wheel, underlying pigments, consultation, colour chart usage and highlighting techniques. Practical activities will complete this workshop.

ADVANCED COLOUR

Full Day Workshop

Most hairdressers can relate to the problems associated with correcting a colour or conducting a scalp bleach service. This workshop aims to make that process not quite so difficult and increase the confidence of students to determine colour selection and best colour techniques to correct unwanted colours and tones. Practical activities will complete this workshop.
